Swim tests will be available during Check-in to youth and adults who are participating in Boating classes. All Aquatics activities are subject to weather.

Prerequisites: ALL Campers (youth and adult) wishing to enter the water MUST complete a BSA Swim Test. Completion of the test will determine what area(s) Scouts and Adults can swim in. Documented "pre-camp" tests will be honored, however, Camp Aquatics Staff have the right to RETEST anyone who does not seem to be an able swimmer, at their discretion. Testing at the lake is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED, as lake swimming can be a different experience from pool swimming for many Scouts.

Further Down the Trail (WEBELOS ONLY)

Loess Hills Nature Hike

Join the staff for a hike through the Prairie Bowl at Little Sioux! Campers will also get to make "Dino Egg" seed bombs that will be dispersed throughout the prairie bowl for new plants to grow!
