**Prerequisites:** ALL Campers (youth and adult) wishing to enter the water MUST complete a BSA Swim Test. Completion of the test will determine what area(s) Scouts and Adults can swim in. Documented "pre-camp" tests will be honored, however, Camp Aquatics Staff have the right to RETEST anyone who does not seem to be an able swimmer, at their discretion. Testing at the lake is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED, as lake swimming can be a different experience from pool swimming for many Scouts.
